STATEMENT

BY THE HEADS OF MEMBER STATES OF THE SHANGHAI COOPERATION ON THE OCCASION OF THE 70-TH ANNIVERSARY OF VICTORY OVER FASCISM IN THE SECOND WORLD WAR
